

## Designing a Questionnaire

Now that we have looked at questionnaire design, this is an opportunity for you to apply what you have learnt.

Below is an example of a questionnaire designed to find out whether men and women share domestic tasks equally.

Your task is as follows:

1. Identify the questions which are well designed.
2. Identify the problems with the questionnaire
3. Re-write the questionnaire, including the introduction, solving the problems that you have identified in question 2.
